Saturday night my family embarked on our 4th of July tradition: We piled into our van and drove around watching fireworks. What we saw this year was unlike any year before. As we drove around Union City, there were fireworks going off everywhere! In every neighborhood and at every turn there were people celebrating and lighting up the night sky. It seemed much different this year, both in the feel of the night and the quantity of the fireworks. For one night during an insane year, everyone wanted to celebrate the same thing at the same time. The American spirit was on full display, if only for a few short hours.

As I reflect on that night, on that celebration, and on the release that fireworks seemed to provide communities across the nation, I long for that same outpouring of celebration in our church. When Jesus made His triumphal entry into Jerusalem to kick off what we call the Passion week, He was surrounded by crowds celebrating and worshiping Him. The Pharisees, party poopers as they always were, told Him to rebuke His disciples for their behavior. Do you remember His response? Luke 19:40 says, "He answered, 'I tell you, if these were silent, the very stones would cry out.'" He was (and is) so worthy of worship and celebration, that if mankind had failed to do so, then creation itself would have cried out.

Our Lord is worthy of worship. He's worthy of enthusiastic, all consuming, raise I want to call on you to begin preparing for worship on Sunday. That's right:

I saw people across this city showing that type of celebration for our country which, if we're honest, has seen far better years than 2020.
