Each life that has been taken through the evil of abortion bore a distinct DNA that had never existed and will never exist again. On this Sunday, we pause to remember those precious lives and the potential that could have been.

Through your faithful tithes we are able to support two distinct pregnancy centers in our region. We are thankful for the work of both Agape House in Matin, as well as LifeBeat in Tiptonville. 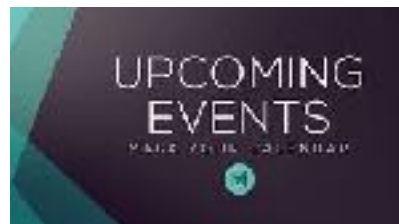
TESTIFY
