

As the calendar turns to April, our attention as Christians shifts to the cross of Calvary and the empty tomb. Flowers are beginning to bloom, grass is growing and life is emerging from the harshness of winter. All

Then, on Saturday, May 13th our Women's Ministry will be sponsoring a Women's Luncheon. Cost is \$10 per person. Speaker will be Debra Johnson with worship led by Brady & Billie Dee Chandler.

Finally, many of you have expressed interest in joining me next April for a once in a lifetime trip to the Holy Land. I can tell you that we have locked in April 19-28, 2018 as the dates for our trip. However, I will not be able to publish a price until mid-June due to flight block releases. When those are finalized you will be able to officially book your spot. Our trip will accommodate 45 participants so there should be no issue with availability. A \$300 non-refundable deposit to be paid no later than November 19, 2017 will be required to reserve your spot with final payment due by January 28, 2018.


