As the calendar turns to April, our attention as Christians shifts to the cross of Calvary and the empty tomb. Flowers are beginning to bloom, grass is growing and life is emerging from the harshness of winter. All around us we will see through nature the hope that Easter offers. The bible says in 1 Peter 1:3, "Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His great mercy has caused us to be born again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead." I pray that this Easter you will join us to celebrate our living hope, Jesus Christ. 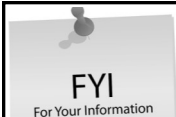
