When you have a healthy, growing plant, one way to increase its production is to take a cutting and plant it. I remember my mom showing me how to do it. She would take a cutting from a plant, set it in water, let the roots develop, and then plant it in the ground. After a few months of care, we had a brand new plant in our garden without harming the original. In fact, the original plant continues to grow and thrive. It's amazing how God created plants with the ability to reproduce through cuttings!

The same principle works with healthy, growing Sunday School classes. On my very first Sunday at Second Baptist, I visited the Young Couples class and saw a growing group in need of space, so we literally tore the walls down and expanded their room. And they have continued to grow. So on May 7th, the Young Couples are planting a new class. Kent & Regina Hendon will start a new group for couples in their 20's and early 30's that will meet in L-219. God has blessed Kent & Regina's ministry for many years and they are faithful and loving tenders to God's growth in our Sunday School program. God can produce the same growth in any faithful class, and maybe yours can be the next one to plant a new flower in the Sunday School garden!
