What is a Great Commission Moment?

This week your Sunday School teacher will ask if you have a Great Commission Moment to share with the class. What is a Great Commission Moment? The best illustration is Jesus' interaction with the woman at the well in John 4. Jesus starts talking to the woman about water, guides the conversation to spiritual matters, and ends by sharing the good news of Him as Messiah. That is a Great Commission Moment, when an interaction with a person leads to a discussion of Jesus and a presentation of the gospel.

We as a staff have committed to hold each other accountable for sharing our faith at least once a week. I've challenged our Sunday School teachers to do the same, and asked them to extend that challenge to their classes. I've asked them to begin class by sharing their own Great Commission Moment from the week and then ask you to share yours. So will you be prepared this Sunday for the question? Will you share your faith this week? I pray you will follow the example of your staff and teachers and take to heart the calling of the Great Commission!


