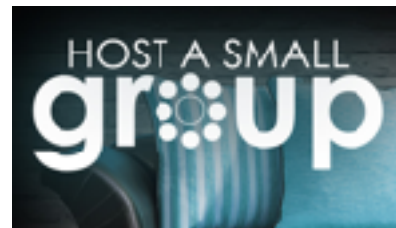
In showing our appreciation for the constant task of protecting and serving the community, we will deliver meals and thank you cards to the departments of police, fire, sheriff and rescue squad.
